

The Assistive Technology (AT) team at Living Opportunities is working on two projects. We are developing a Learning Collaboration team to assist agencies statewide in developing their own internal AT teams. We are also developing a class curriculum for families to learn how to best use their devices and get connected with beneficial resources.

Thrive, Independently

Living Opportunities has realized a long-term strategic goal of providing three-bed homes to the people served by our Residential Services program.

In February 2020, a unique partnership enabled us to acquire another home, thereby reducing the number of people living together. Additionally, the transition assists us in pursuing our mission by giving our residents choice in how they live in neighborhoods throughout our community. The new arrangement also enables more personalized support to meet each person's unique needs.

Did you know it requires over 250 hours of weekly support—13,000 hours annually—provided 24 hours a day, 365 days a year by up to eight trained Direct Support Professionals to assist three people to live as independently as possible in their homes?

By partnering with Living Opportunities, you can help the individuals we serve find housing solutions that best suit their needs. We start by building relationships with property management companies, apartment and single family home owners, and land developers within the community.
